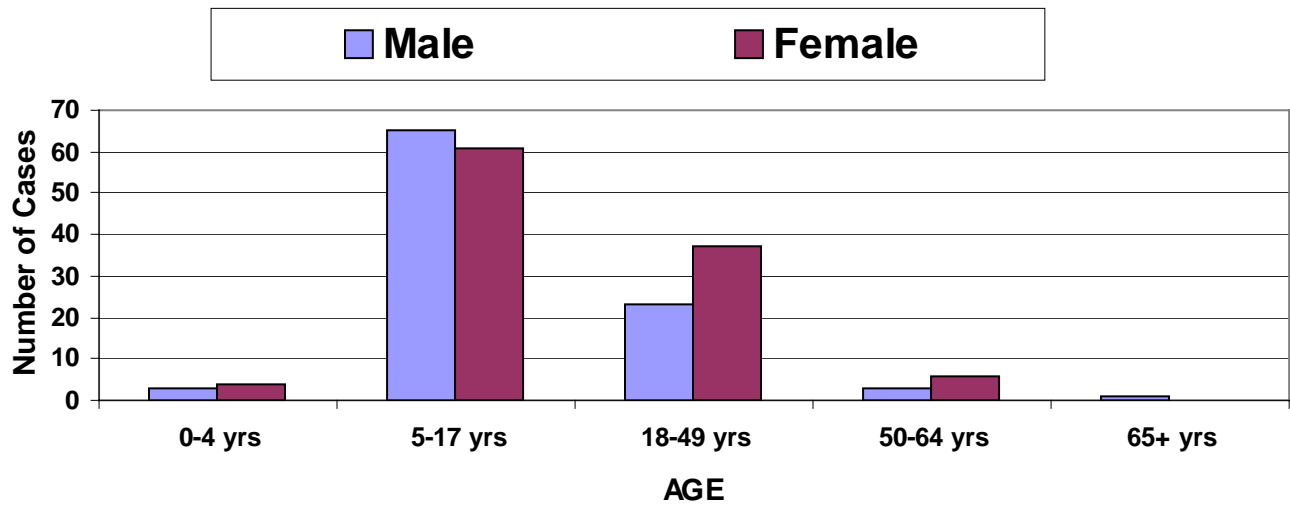

Please Note: Further case count updates will not be posted to the DHHS website as testing recommendations have changed as of June 11, 2009. Individual tests and identification of individual cases are less meaningful as evidence of community transmission has been well-established in NH. All testing for H1N1 and seasonal influenza, including rapid tests, should be limited to hospitalized patients, healthcare workers and people that may be part of a cluster, in consultation with public health. We expect that our traditional surveillance for influenza will continue to detect H1N1 along with other circulating strains of influenza virus through the summer months. These recommendations are interim and may change based upon new developments.

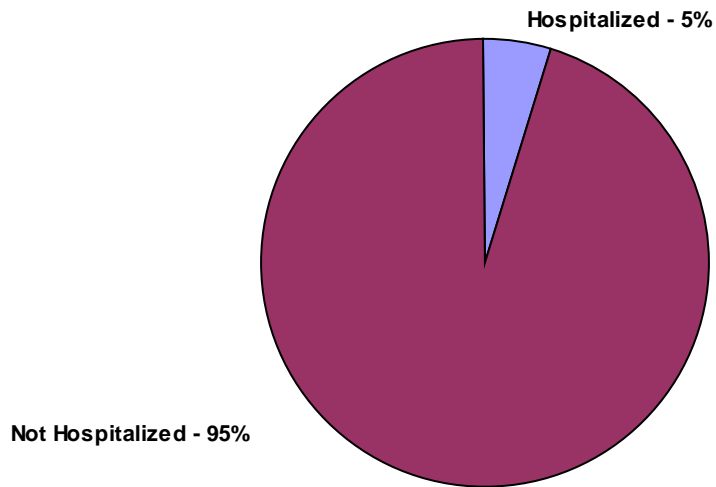
